- Get your Identification documents in order
- Obtain proof of any education or classes you completed while incarcerated
- Get your medical records
- Confirm your housing
- Find out about outstanding fines, fees, debts, or warrants
- If you are a veteran, make sure you have your military discharge papers
- Ask family or friends to bring you some necessities on the day of your release
- Get a working phone/ phone number
- Find somewhere to access the internet
- Create an email address
- Signup for health insurance
- Get proof of your GED/ High School diploma
- Confirm your selective service status
- Take control of your finances
- Connect with assistance programs and community organizations that can help
- Continue your education
- Begin your job search
- Get legal assistance if you need it
- Focus on rebuilding relationships
- Don't forget to take care of yourself

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
