\square If you are a veteran, make sure you have your military discharge papers
□Ask family or friends to bring you some necessities on the day of your
release
☐ Get a working phone/ phone number
\square Find somewhere to access the internet
☐ Create an email address
☐ Signup for health insurance
☐ Get proof of your GED/ High School diploma
☐ Confirm your selective service status
☐ Take control of your finances
□Connect with assistance programs and community organizations that can
help
☐ Continue your education
☐ Begin your job search
☐ Get legal assistance if you need it
☐ Focus on rebuilding relationships
☐ Don't forget to take care of yourself
